Roebuck student graduates from Furman University

Greenville - Furman University President Elizabeth Davis presided over the class of 2021 commencement exercises, which took place Saturday, May 8, at Paladin Stadium on campus.

Six hundred fifteen students graduated in the class of 2021. Jake Henjes of Roebuck, graduated cum laude with a Bachelor of Music in Music Education. Henjes's parents and/or guardians are Shana Henjes and Doug Henjes.

SCC Foundation receives a \$56,105 grant from the Timken Foundation for SCC Tyger River Campus educational equipment

The Timken Foundation awarded the Spartanburg Community College Foundation \$56,105 to increase access to high-quality educational equipment in healthcare, welding and massage therapy at the SCC Tyger River Campus in Duncan. Funds from the Timken Foundation grant will purchase cutting-edge equipment and upgrade the lighting in classrooms at the Duncan campus, allowing SCC students to learn invaluable skills on industry-specific equipment.

Thanks to this grant, the college will purchase innovative simulation equipment for new courses taught by SCC's Corporate and Career Education division in healthcare education including certified nursing assistant, emergency medical technician, patient care technician and phlebotomy. This new equipment will provide students with real-world educational experiences to better prepare them for future careers in healthcare.

The Timken grant also allows the college's CCE division to establish its first welding certification program at the Tyger River Campus by funding a new welding lab that includes cutting-edge welding machinery for 10 welding booths. These new booths provide students firsthand welding experience throughout their SCC educational journey, so they are skill-ready on day one of a new job.

Finally, students pursuing an SCC massage therapy certificate or associate degree in applied science at the Tyger River Campus can now learn and practice a greater variety of professional massage techniques using two new, state-of-the-art massage tables.

Dickerson adds Spartanburg native Anthony Johnson to Upstate men's basketball coaching staff

USC Upstate head men's basketball coach Dave Dickerson has announced the addition of Anthony Johnson to the coaching staff as an assistant coach.

Johnson, a native of Spartanburg and graduate of James F. Byrnes High School, was most recently the director of development and recruiting at Georgia Southern University.

Prior to his time at Georgia Southern, Johnson spent the 2019-20 season as the director of player development/video coordinator at the College of Charleston assisting with recruiting, video editing, scouting and academic progress.

Notably, Johnson served as a graduate assistant coach at Texas Tech in 2018-19 during the Red Raiders' 31-7 Final Four campaign that culminated in an overtime battle against Virginia in the National Championship game.

Johnson earned his bachelor's degree in parks, recreation and tourism management with a minor in sociology from Clemson in 2012 and earned his master's degree in interdisciplinary studies at Texas Tech in May of 2019.

During his prep career, he was a three-year basketball letterwinner at James F. Byrnes High School in Duncan, S.C. He was selected to the all-region, all-area and two-time all-tournament team. After graduation, Johnson was a two-year basketball letterman at Lees-McRae College before transferring to Clemson.

Celebrating the future of philanthropy

The Spartanburg County Foundation hosted an opening ceremony for The Robert Hett Chapman III Center for Philanthropy, South Carolina's first center for philanthropy, on Tuesday, June 29th. The new center is located at 431 E. Kennedy Street on the campus of The Spartanburg County Foundation. After a delay due to COVID-19 precautions, the Center opened to the public with some limits on capacity. Over 100 community leaders gathered for the ribbon cutting and to tour the facility.

"This is a historic occasion as we open the first center for philanthropy in the state," said Mary Thomas, Executive Director for the new center and Chief Operating Officer of The Spartanburg County Foundation. "This building is a community asset and represents the limitless possibilities of what can happen when we come together to generate change, not only in Spartanburg County, but also throughout the South-

east region."

In 2019, as part of its 75th anniversary, the Foundation announced plans to build the Center for Philanthropy and establish a collaborative, shared space that increases the Foundation's role as convener and thought leader in the community. By combining convening facilities, state-of-the-art technology, and data-driven decision making, the Center is a hub for individuals and organizations to gain knowledge and leadership tools to take action and verify transformative change.

"The Robert Hett Chapman III Center for Philanthropy will bring new tools and new ideas that will help build the capacity of nonprofit organizations of all sizes, which is so important after a very challenging year for these organizations," said Troy Hanna, Chief Executive Officer at The Spartanburg County Foundation. "Through this ceremony, we wanted to celebrate and to thank our gen-

erous donors who have invested in this Center that will shape our community's future."

In addition to the center's value to the community, there is one small physical feature that will reap great benefits to the environment. Spartanburg Water System partnered with The Spartanburg County Foundation to install one of the newest Choose Tap water fountain and bottle refilling stations in the Center for Philanthropy. Launched by Spartanburg Water in 2016, the Choose Tap program seeks to promote the value of tap water by encouraging our Spartanburg community to consider the significant benefits of turning on the tap. This partnership fits well with the Center's vision and contributes to its value as a gathering place where members from all walks of life can discover and engage in the role of philanthropy in the life of Spartanburg County.

The Mary Black School of Nursing gets federal funding for Nurse Faculty Loan Program

The University of South Carolina Upstate recently announced its Mary Black School of Nursing has been awarded a nearly \$76,000 grant from the federal Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) in support of its Nurse Faculty Loan Program (NFLP). Announcement of the grant comes just after the school learned it will receive a four-year, \$1.95 million grant from HRSA to support its Holistic Opportunities and Partnerships that Empower (HOPE) Nursing Success Project. MBSON also recently learned it had earned reaccreditation from the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education, having met the industry's highest standards.

This latest grant will serve as a loan fund from NFLP to cover the costs of tuition, fees, books and reasonable education

expenses for graduate nursing students enrolled in USC Upstate's Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) Education program.

"Once again our incredible Mary Black School of Nursing has received national recognition for the assistance it's providing our students," said USC Provost David Schechter, Ph.D. "I could not be more proud of the school's dean and faculty. They are constantly in pursuit of new ideas, new resources to support student success, and new ways to help improve the nursing profession."

MBSON Dean Shirleatha Lee, Ph.D., RN, said faculty shortages are the primary reason why nursing schools turn away qualified applicants to their programs.

Lee noted that the NFLP has three primary objectives:

* To provide financial

support to MBSON students enrolled in its MSN Education program.

* Graduate MSN Education students who meet the National League of Nursing Nurse Educator Competencies.

* To support MBSON MSN Education graduates in acquiring employment in a nurse faculty role within 12 months of degree completion.

Toshua Kennedy, Ph.D., MPH, PHCNS-BC, will serve as the project director of the award, which totals \$75,956.

"This is yet another win for Dr. Lee and her team," said USC Upstate Interim Chancellor Derham Cole. "More importantly, it is another opportunity for USC Upstate to continue to provide transformational opportunities and improve health care for residents of the Upstate region of South Carolina and beyond."

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Around the Upstate

Rotary Club of Spartanburg awards over \$29,000 in Youth Opportunity Grants

Rotary Club of Spartanburg has awarded over \$29,000 recently in Youth Opportunity Grants to seven local organizations.

Youth Opportunity Grants are one of the Rotary Club of Spartanburg's signature projects; these competitive grants benefit hundreds of students every year. Among the current uses of funds are leadership training, educational enrichment, science education, pediatric dental referrals, development of independent living skills and drowning prevention classes. In 2021, they received 20 requests totaling \$82,511. The Club funded seven requests for a total of \$29,262.

The process began with a Request for Proposals that was distributed through the United Way, the Spartanburg County Foundation, the Spartanburg Academic Movement, the Mary Black Foundation, the Chapman Cultural Center, and club members. Applications were received, committee members read and score them. Grants were awarded based on aggregate scoring.

Organizations funded in 2021 and a description of their programs are:

* The Citizens Scholars Institute has been awarded \$2,856 to support its Emerging Leaders Internship Program. Thirty-two eleventh grade Scholars participated in an intensive three-day leadership immersion course, served as peer-mentors to rising sixth and seventh grade Scholars, and served as facilitators at the CS annual conference, "The Summit: Opportunity Looks Like Hard Work," which was held in June, on the campus of the Evans Academic Center of Spartanburg Community College.

* Healthy Smiles of Spartanburg has been awarded \$5,000 to support the Pediatric Dental Clinic and Pediatric Specialist Referrals. At the Pediatric Dental Clinic, low-income, uninsured children access no-cost case management, preventative and restorative treatment. However, some children, due to age, behav-

ior and extent of decay, need specialized treatment including sedation that Healthy Smiles coordinates with pediatric specialists. This program will provide access to preventative and specialized care, and mitigate the potential for emergent dental or medical treatment.

* Hope Center for Children has been awarded \$4,049 to support the development of an incentive room at the Faucette House shelter, which recently began serving a higher-risk foster population. The incentive room will be aimed at the teenage population living at the shelter and will help to build independent living skills through goal setting and behavior modification while the teens heal from trauma and abuse. Access to the incentive room will be earned through an accrued point system.

* The Palmetto Council of Boy Scouts of America has been awarded \$4,500 to support a week-long summer camp experience at the Glendale Outdoor Leadership School (GOLS) for members of the TK Gregg Community Center Cub Scout pack. At GOLS, youth will be able to participate in biking, rock climbing, fishing, and hiking. Palmetto Council will also

provide programs on topics such as Health, Safety, and First Aid; Sports and Physical Fitness; Healthy Eating Habits and Nutrition; Wood Work and Building; and Outdoor Skills.

* The Salvation Army of Spartanburg and Union Counties has been awarded \$4,000 to support its Summer Day Camp Program. The program operates from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday for nine-weeks during the summer. It is designed to help at-risk children in our area have a safe, secure place to be during the summer months. The children receive snacks and a meal daily, physical activities, trips to local museums and parks, and character-building skills.

* VCOM has been awarded \$3,857 to support its Research Institute Young Investigators Science Camp Program, which is an informal science education program designed to combat the lack of student diversity for those entering the STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math education) fields. A group of 10-20 middle school students will participate in the VCOM science camp focusing on life sciences. Funds will be used to provide a hands-on research

experience, e.g. extracting and analyzing DNA to illustrate basic biological scientific methods to students. Other materials, including shirts, bags and journals are take-home items so students can show their participation and record their activities during the event.


* The YMCA of Greater Spartanburg has been awarded \$5,000 to provide free swimming lessons using YMCA Safety Around Water curriculum for 60 children and teens from low-income homes in Spartanburg County, focusing on the Northside and District 7. Additionally, funds will be used to provide teens living in the Northside and Highland communities with free lifeguard certification classes to prepare them for employ-

ment from the Northside and Highland Communities who achieve these certifications will be considered top-priority candidates for employment.

Youth Opportunity Grants have been a line item in the Spartanburg Rotary Club

budget for many years. Part of the funding comes from the annual Spartanburg Sings event, which brings together middle school students from across the county for a one-afternoon musical performance. Spartanburg Sings has been another way the Spartanburg Rotary Club serves youth, and it has become very popular among middle school administrators, faculty and students.

Rotary is an organization of business and professional leaders united worldwide who provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations, and help build goodwill and peace in the world. The Rotary Club of Spartanburg provides both voluntary and financial support for a number of service, educational and humanitarian efforts. The Garden Bug

Ground beetles are considered beneficial, as the adults are voracious eaters, and prey on bothersome pests such as ants, aphids, flies, cabbage worms, potato beetles, corn earworms, cutworms and lots of slugs. Some even eat weed seeds. They cannot climb, so they are limited to the ground as they forage nocturnally (hence their name). A ground beetle can actually live one to three years, so they can provide much pest control in exchange for a humble home in your garden under some dead leaves. Avoid using any pesticides around them. —Brenda Weaver

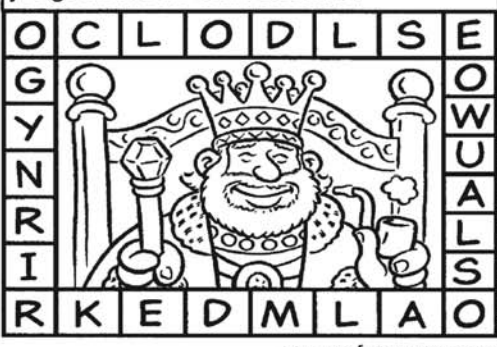

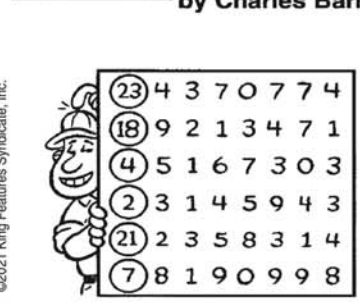

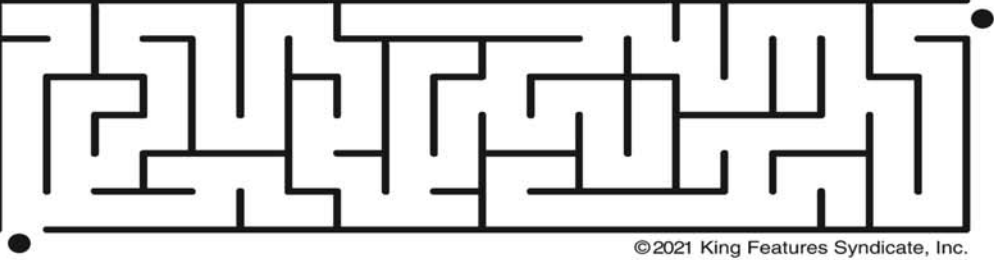
MEMORY MAGIC!
