City Council hears update on Blue Duck scooter rental pilot program

Spartanburg City Council heard an update Monday, October 25 on the six-month scooter-sharing pilot program the City launched with Blue Duck scooters of San Antonio, Texas in May. According to numbers provided by the company, over 14,300 riders have used the scooters between May and September, with a peak of 4,794 in July. Those numbers are better than what Blue Duck initially anticipated when launching in Spartanburg according to company representatives. The service area for the scooters includes Downtown Spartanburg and surrounding neighborhoods in the City. The scooters utilize GPS technology, and will not function outside their service area or within areas that have been restricted.

The City has worked closely with Blue Duck throughout the pilot program ensure rider and pedestrian safety while providing a new micromobility option for residents and visitors, restricting riders from the Morgan Square area and E Main Street between Liberty St. and Church St due to higher number of pedestrians in those areas. The scooters are also restricted from city trails.

City Council is expected to consider an extension of the scooter-sharing program at their next meeting on November 8.

USC Upstate athletics announces change in leadership of the women's soccer program

University of South Carolina Upstate announced a change in leadership in its women's soccer program Thursday, October 28. Tyson John's contract was not renewed after six seasons leading USC Upstate's women's soccer program.

John began his tenure at Upstate on July 18, 2016, as the fourth head coach since the program's inception in 2000. He departs as the winningest coach in the program's D1 era with a 27-58-9 overall mark, 12-36-4 in conference play.

A national search for the next leader of Upstate's women's soccer program is underway.

USDA to make up to \$1.5 billion available to help rural communities access high-speed internet

Columbia – U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Secretary Tom Vilsack recently announced a significant expansion of access to high-speed internet, health care and educational services for millions of rural Americans nationwide.

Secretary Vilsack spoke about USDA's commitment to helping rural Americans get improved access to broadband and health care during a visit to the newly renovated emergency department at Hammond Henry Hospital. The project was financed in part by a USDA loan.

He announced that on November 24 USDA will begin accepting applications for up to \$1.15 billion in loans and grants to expand the availability of broadband in rural areas. USDA is making the funding available through the ReConnect Program.

Biscuit box

The English spoken in England can sometimes confuse an American because the same word can mean different things in the two countries. Almost every tourist learns that in England a "lift" is an elevator. But who has been warned that an English "biscuit" is what an American calls a "cookie," and that an American biscuit, also called "shortbread," is a British scone?

Several English silver-plated biscuit boxes were sold at a Neal auction recently along with labeled rectangular wooden boxes and covers, and decorated tin boxes filled with loose cookies (biscuits) for the store. One of the silver boxes was made by James Dixon & Sons, a well-known Sheffield manufacturer that worked from 1804 to 1992. It is almost 11 inches high. Each of the shell-shaped bowls had a hinged, pierced flap that kept the heat and the biscuits in place when the sides were opened and became flat bowls to serve the cookies. The flaps are often missing when the biscuit box is sold.

Q: How can I clean the marble top on an antique chest? The chest is probably over 100 years old. There are some stains on the marble that look like some kind of liquid spilled on it.

A: The easy way is to buy a commercial marble stain remover. You can also try a home remedy. Wash the marble top with dishwashing liquid and hot water, rinse well and dry thoroughly. Use a soft cloth or a bristle brush if needed. Then you can try one of the many do-it-yourself methods.

Different solutions clean different types of stains. If the marble is a light color, try a mixture of several tablespoons of 6% hydrogen peroxide and a tablespoon of baking soda. Mix into a thick paste, the consistency of peanut butter. Spread it in a 1/4-inch-thick layer on the stain. Cover with plastic wrap, tape the edges and let it dry for 24 hours. Use a plastic (not metal) spatula or a damp sponge to remove the paste, rinse and buff dry. Repeat the process if necessary. Recipes for the mixture use 6% to 12% hydrogen peroxide. Some add a little ammonia and more baking soda. There are many mixtures mentioned online. Good luck. Some stains can't be removed.

SCC announces \$1.3 million Department of Education TRIO Talent Search Grant for Cherokee County

Recently, Spartanburg Community College announced the college has been awarded a TRIO Talent Search Grant totaling \$1,386,720 over the next five years. The grant will be used to operate the federally funded Talent Search Program project at the SCC Cherokee County Campus in order to facilitate outreach to middle school, high school, and alternative school students in Cherokee County and help them plan for and achieve their goals in higher education.

This is the first time SCC has received this grant funding, making it the only college in the Upstate and one of just five colleges statewide to have been awarded a TRIO Talent Search Grant.
