SMC names new Dean for Online Programming

Dr. Lena Maslennikova has joined Spartanburg Methodist College as the new Dean of Online Instruction, to oversee content and development for SMC Online.

AFL awards \$87K in grants to support Upstate SC organizations

AFL presented \$87,000 in community grants to 16 organizations in the Upstate of South Carolina. Through AFL's Community Outreach Program, funds were awarded to nonprofit organizations in the Upstate of South Carolina to support the focus areas of STEM Education, Youth Development and LEAP (Life Enrichment and Advancement Programs).

The following organizations received grants for during the summer cycle:

Children's Cancer Partners—received \$10,000 in funding that will support childhood cancer treatment travel program.

The Children's Museum of the Upstate—was the recipient of a \$7,500 grant, which will support its scholarship program by covering the difference in discounted admission rates for museum tickets.

GirlUp GVL—received \$3,000 to support their GrowU Summer Internship Program, which expands life skills and training for participants.

Hope Center for Children—received \$5,000 in funding that will support clinical support services for the organization.

Hub City Farmers Market—received \$3,500 to support educational materials and training costs for the youth crew at the Urban Farm.

Pendleton Place—received \$5,000, which will support the efforts of the organization in empowering homeless youth through technology.

Roper Mountain Science Center Association—received \$5,000 that will support the new fourth grade stem lab.

South Carolina Governors' School—was the recipient of a \$7,500 grant that will support the efforts to introduce STEM-based studies and careers to diverse populations.

The Walker Foundation/SC School for Deaf & Blind—received \$7,500 in funds that will be used to support the Encoding Success program.

United Ministries—received \$5,000 in funding that will support participants in the Striving to Thrive program, which builds self-efficacy while improving their financial and overall well-being.

Upcountry History Museum—received \$1,500 in funds that will support STEM educational programs for the museum.

Upstate Family Resource Center—received \$5,000 in support of their Education for Life program.

YMCA Judson Community Center—received \$5,000, the funding will support the YMCA Summer Days program.

YMCA of Greater Spartanburg—was the recipient of a \$10,000 award that will be used to support the YMCA's Annual Scholarship Fund.

YouthBase—was the recipient of a \$5,000 grant for its educational after school program, which serves at-risk children who are referred by teachers as below-average grade level.

World Upside Down—received \$2,000 to support its afterschool program which provides homework assistance to students.

Organizations awarded opioid settlement funds for prevention efforts

Information provided by POWER Collective

A Greenville-based prevention coalition, POWER Collective, said it was awarded \$814,915.00 in opioid settlement funds by the South Carolina Opioid Recovery Fund Board, signaling one of the first state-specific payouts.

The POWER Collective: Community Action for Opioid Addiction and Overdose Prevention is a comprehensive community initiative comprised of four organizations working together to combat the opioid crisis in Greenville County.

The POWER Collective is working with the Greenville County Sheriff's Office; RIZE Prevention Inc., a nonprofit delivering an innovative school-based drug prevention and early intervention program; Just Say Something, a tobacco, drug and alcohol prevention organization; and Safe Rx, a company on a mission to combat the opioid crisis with its award-winning locking prescription vials.

Said Greenville County Sheriff Hobart Lewis:



The POWER Collective recently received \$814,915.00 in opioid settlement funds.

"The POWER Collective is such an important partnership in our fight to combat opioid addiction. It is so essential to partner with those who have the same mission in helping those get off these dangerous drugs by providing resources and educational opportunities to see the process through."

The POWER Collective will provide education, awareness, prevention, and intervention related to opioid and other gateway drug use to organizations, like churches, schools, and businesses.

It will implement evidence-informed prevention strategies, such as reduced social access and

physical access, stigma reduction, educational campaigns, support for people in treatment or recovery, and training of coalitions in evidence-informed implementation, including by following the Strategic Prevention Framework developed by the U.S. Substance Abuse and Mental Health

Services Administration (SAMHSA).

The funds will be used beginning December 2023.

Officials said the opioid settlement funds granted to the POWER Collective come at a pivotal time for Greenville County, which ranked eighth in the state for opioid-involved overdose deaths, according to

one study.

According to the Greenville County Coroner's Office, 78 percent of Greenville County overdoses involved opioids in 2020.

As part of the program, the POWER Collective will distribute Safe Rx Locking Prescription Vials (LPVs) to pharmacies and households across Greenville County.

Safe Rx LPVs are a clinically proven intervention used in both prevention and treatment.

"The opioid/fentanyl crisis is the most challenging and unforgiving crisis our community has ever faced. We will start finding our way out of it only when prevention and treatment receive equal attention and investment," said RIZE Executive Director Martine Helou-Allen.
