2023 NCAA Division I Men's and Women's **Southeast Cross Country Regionals** to be held in Spartanburg

The NCAA recently named Spartanburg as the destination for the 2023 NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Cross-Country Regional Championship, the first post-season NCAA event to come to Spartanburg since USC Upstate entered Division I.

USC Upstate will host the event in partnership with OneSpartanburg, Inc. at the Roger Milliken Center on Friday, Nov. 10.

USC Upstate joins major Division I schools including Arkansas, Florida, and Oklahoma State as host sites for the 2023 NCAA Cross-Country Regionals. In 2021, Spartanburg hosted its first regional championships, the NCAA Division II & Division III Cross-Country Regionals at Milliken.

Spartanburg City Council approves creation of Morgan Square Redevelopment Committee

At the Monday, July 25th meeting, Spartanburg City Council voted 5-0 to approve the creation of a committee to make recommendations on physical enhancements to Morgan Square. Council members Jamie Fulmer and Erica Brown were absent from the meeting. The committee comprises a diverse selection of city residents and stakeholders including downtown restaurant and retail business owners, City planning board members, experts in local development and architecture, and community activists. In presenting the recommended list of committee members Council, City Manager Chris Story said that in addition to a diversity of experience and background, the committee also includes a diversity of opinions about what

Spartanburg's most prominent piece of public land.

Story said that the committee's work will take 6-12 months and will involve a robust public engagement process. After their work is complete, the new committee will make final recommendations to City Council regarding

changes to the square. The move comes after City Council voted 4-3 last August to continue the closure of W Main Street in front of Morgan Square for 12 months to establish a planning process to consider a permanent reconfiguration of the space. Council members Jamie Fulmer, Rob Rain, and Erica Brown voted against, favoring a proposal that would've opened the street during the winter months and closed it again and Chairman, Contec, in the spring. Separate Inc. from the square redesign discussion, Council will take up extending the street closure at their next Lynch, County Council meeting on August 8.

Spartanburg-based OTO Development acquires DoubleTree by Hilton in North Redington Beach

OTO Development has added the DoubleTree by Hilton in North Redington Beach, Florida, to its growing beachfront leisure portfolio.

should come next for

Spartanburg-based OTO Development, which is part of The Johnson Group, acquired Double-Tree Beach Resort by Hilton Tampa Bay-North Redington Beach from the property's original private ownership group. The transaction, brokered by The Plasencia Group, closed on Monday, July 18.

"We are so intrigued by this DoubleTree, which has long been loved for its ideal location and resortstyle amenities," says Corry Oakes, CEO of OTO Development. "There's incredible opportunity in combining an individual hotel's attributes with our company's scaled operational efficiencies."

Built in 1987, the 7story, 125-room hotel was constructed to maximize frontage along the Gulf of Mexico. The majority of guest rooms have balconies overlooking the beach — just 150 feet away from the water —

and many rooms on the non-Gulf side enjoy water views of Boca Ciega Bay. An oceanfront restaurant extends onto an expansive veranda and out to a festive tiki hut, which is adjacent to an outdoor pool. Also facing the Gulf is a 1,272-square-foot meeting room that can accommodate up to 125 people.

"North Redington Beach nestled mid-way between St. Pete Beach and Clearwater Beach the No. 1 and No. 18 most popular beaches in the United States, per Tripadvisor," Oakes says. "This well-positioned DoubleTree provides a full-service option for travelers who want a relax-

ing Gulf Coast getaway." Upon swap of keys, OTO will immediately implement scaled efficiencies in operations, revenue management and marketing support. An extensive renovation, planned to begin late summer 2023, will comprise a total refresh in all common spaces; aesthetic updates and bath upgrades in guest rooms; and enhancements to the exterior. The hotel will remain open during renovations and, upon completion, will continue under the DoubleTree by Hilton flag.

DoubleTree in North Redington Beach is the 10th oceanfront property OTO has purchased since Q4 2018 and one of seven along the coastlines of Florida. In addition to this latest acquisition, the company's on-the-sand portfolio includes hotels in Key West, Marathon, Panama City Beach, St. Pete Beach, Fort Walton Beach and Cocoa Beach, Florida; Myrtle Beach, South Carolina; Wrightsville Beach, North Carolina; and Ocean City, Maryland. OTO's new Hyatt Place in Panama City Beach is opening soon; other leisure developments and acquisitions are in the pipeline.

S.C. Ports opens state-of-the-art Hugh K. Leatherman Terminal

Charleston - South Carolina Ports made history recently welcoming the first vessel to the Hugh K. Leatherman Terminal, marking the first container terminal to open in the U.S. since 2009.

Operations launched March 30 with the arrival of the first container, followed by the first ship arrival recently with Hapag Lloyd's Yorktown Express.

"The Hugh K. Leatherman Terminal is an investment in the future of South Carolina that will spur economic development, create jobs, and further our state's position as an international business destination for years to come," Governor Henry McMaster said. "This project is a momentous achievement which highlights the strengths of Team South Carolina. I congratulate the South Carolina Ports Authority and everyone who has worked towards achieving this historic day."

The Leatherman Terminal, which has been 20 years in the making, is a generational milestone for SC Ports and for South Carolina. The terminal sits along the Cooper River in North Charleston, near Charleston Harbor. Its cranes can be seen throughout the region the changed skyline serving as a reminder of Charleston's success as a port city.

The Leatherman Terminal can efficiently work the biggest ships calling on East Coast ports. Phase One adds 700,000 TEUs of throughput capacity to the

Port of Charleston.

SC Ports CEO Jim Newsome said that the opening of the terminal comes at just the right time, as U.S. container ports continue to handle unprecedented cargo volumes amid strong consumer demand. SC Ports had an all-time cargo record in March, with a year-over-year increase in loaded imports.

"SC Ports is extremely proud to open the first container terminal in the U.S. since 2009 in South Carolina. This took years of effort by our team and project partners," Newsome said. "We have invested in the right infrastructure at the right time to handle growing cargo volumes and bigger ships, ensuring SC Ports remains a top 10 U.S. container port. The Leatherman Terminal adds a berth and more capacity to the Port

of Charleston when it is most needed on the East Coast. We made history today as we advance SC Ports' capabilities and enhance South Carolina's supply chain for generations to come. Tomorrow is here at SC Ports."

Capabilities and capacity The state-of-the-art

Leatherman Terminal strengthens SC Ports' bigship capabilities and provides much-needed capacity to the East Coast. Its equipment, technology and design provide reliable, efficient service to cus-

Its 1,400-foot berth can handle a 20,000-TEU vessel. Five electric ship-toshore cranes with 169 feet of lift height and 228 feet of outreach stand on the berth, ready to move cargo on and off container ships. These cranes are among the tallest on the East Coast.

The Leatherman Terminal's 47-acre container yard has 25 hybrid rubbertired gantry cranes and eight empty container handlers to efficiently move cargo boxes around the terminal. The rubber-tired gantry cranes are designed to reduce emissions and energy consumption.

A six-acre refrigerated cargo area has six-story tall refrigerated container racks, enabling SC Ports to handle more fresh, refrigerated and frozen goods.

At full buildout, the \$2 billion Leatherman Terminal will have three berths and 286 acres, adding 2.4 million TEUs of annual throughput capacity, doubling current capacity.

and most significant economic development projects to date. Its impact will be felt by waterfront workers and S.C. businesses for decades to come.

The Leatherman Terminal greatly enhances South Carolina's supply chain, and a well-run port with capacity is an attractive asset for companies.

"SC Ports has long been the economic engine of South Carolina, and the opening of the Leatherman Terminal will generate more investments in our communities and highpaying jobs for South Carolinians," said Sen. Hugh K. Leatherman, the terminal's namesake. "SC Ports has seen tremendous growth over the past decade as bigger cargo ships continually call on the Port of Charleston. The modern container terminal greatly expands SC Ports' capacity and capabilities.

The Leatherman Terminal is part of SC Ports' \$2 billion infrastructure investment plan, which also involves enhancing Wando Welch Terminal. With these combined investments, SC Ports can handle four 14,000-TEU vessels simultaneously an impressive capability that few U.S. ports can

The Charleston Harbor Deepening Project is on track to achieve 52 feet of depth this year, making it the deepest harbor on the East Coast. SC Ports also looks to develop near-dock rail capabilities with the future Navy Base Intermodal Facility, located about a mile from the Leatherman Terminal, and an inner-harbor barge sys-

"South Carolina's successful supply chain is a direct result of the strategic investments made in port infrastructure that allows us to handle bigger ships and more cargo," SC Ports Board Chairman Bill Stern said. "The opening of the Leatherman Terminal is a hugely significant milestone for SC Ports and for South Carolina as a whole, setting us up for continued success."


Goodwill celebrates the grand opening of new Business Services Center
