Chapman Cultural Center to receive \$250,000 grant as part of American Rescue Plan

Chapman Cultural Center was recently selected to receive an American Rescue Plan grant from the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) to help the arts and cultural sector recover from the pandemic. In total, the NEA will award grants totaling \$20,200,000 to 66 local arts agencies nationwide for sub-granting. Chapman Cultural Center is receiving \$250,000 and will use this funding to distribute grants within Spartanburg County to eligible organizations to save jobs and fund operations and facilities, health and safety supplies, and marketing and promotional efforts to participation.

"The NEA's significant investment in local arts agencies, including Chapman Cultural Center is a key element in helping the arts and culture sector recover and reopen, while ensuring that American Rescue Plan funding is distributed equitably," said Ann Eilers, NEA's acting chair. "These grants recognize the vital role of local arts agencies and will allow them to help rebuild local economies and contribute to the well-being of our communities."

"It is an honor to receive a grant from the NEA. This grant will provide critical support for our partner non-profit organizations by helping restore their operating grants back to pre-COVID levels," said Lisa O'Connell-Hall, Interim President and CEO. "This will also encourage attendance and advance our goal of making sure that the arts and cultural community is solvent for years to come by progressing towards a forward funding model."

> Chapman Cultural Center plans to use the

funds to supplement existing General Operating Support Grants to pre-COVID levels or beyond. For more than 25 years the Center has awarded GOS funds to local arts and cultural organizations to help them create the best quality arts experiences possible for the Spartanburg Community. Because of the pandemic, available funding decreased as much as 70% from previous years and has slowly returned to 65% percent of pre-COVID levels. However, Spartanburg's arts and cultural community still needs help to thrive again.

At a November event at the Swiss Embassy in Washington, D.C., Spartanburg Community College President Dr. Michael Mikota met with the President of Switzerland, Guy Parmelin and Swiss Ambassador to the United States, Jacques Pitteloud, to discuss the potential for expanded apprenticeship programs.

"It was an honor to meet with President Parmelin and Ambassador Pitteloud and share the success we have seen at Spartanburg Community College and the record breaking investment that is occurring throughout our service area," said Dr. Michael Mikota, president of Spartanburg Community College. Splatterware pitcher

It is easy to guess what this is - a rainbow spatterware water pitcher. But how old is it? Spatterware was first made in the late 1700s in England, but most found today dates from about 1800 to 1850 in Staffordshire, England, made to sell in the United States.

Unfortunately, the word "spatterware" now has several meanings, probably because novice collectors didn't realize there is a difference between spatter and spongeware. Another hazard is that there are fairly good copies of spatterware made today to be used in the kitchen. Experts can tell the old from the new by the shape, weight and the white glaze color. They also know the difference in the look of a spattered paint mark and the mark left by a paint-dipped

Old rainbow spatter like this pitcher is expensive, and the double G-scroll handle is an added value feature. This piece sold with the buyers' premium for \$5,227.

Q: When I bought my beauty shop in 1972, it had a Coke machine. It was made by the Vendo Company of Kansas City. Cokes cost 15 cents. But it isn't the typical red-andwhite Coke machine - the front looks like wood and has eight panels with black trim. The machine still works, and I have it in my home. Could you tell me its value?

A: The Vendo company was started in the late 1930s in Kansas City, Missouri. The Vendo Model 56 vending machine was designed about 1956 and made until the mid-1960s. The machine held 56 bottles, sizes 8 ounces to 12 ounces, in up to seven varieties. It was offered in red and white, red and white with woodgrain, and with woodgrain "decorator doors" that made it look like a cabinet rather than a brightly colored soda machine. Styles included Danish, Provincial, Colonial, Traditional and Mediterranean, like yours.

Vintage Vendo soda vending machines in old and worn but working condition that advertise brands like Coca-Cola or Pepsi sell from about \$250 to about \$500. Coca-Cola versions are worth the most. Restored examples sell into the thousands. Without product advertising, they are worth less, about \$100 to \$300.


Located at 231 Beverly Road in Greenville, the company's new 44,000square-foot facility will enhance and expedite production, testing capabilities



Bronze plaque unveiled of former S.C. Department of Natural Resources director Alvin Taylor

Columbia - Alvin Taylor, lofty bronze plaque that will be a permanent fixture at the agency's Columbia headquarters.

The bronze plaque of Taylor was unveiled November 18 by the S.C. Natural Resources Board at its board meeting held in the third-floor board room of the Rembert Dennis Building in Columbia's Capitol Complex.

After a long and storied career spanning 42 years with the S.C. Department of Natural Resources (SCDNR), including seven years leading the agency, Taylor retired in 2019. He left behind a legacy of

It is the highest honor bestowed by the association and is presented to the career individual who has made the greatest contribution to wildlife or fish conservation during the previous year or years. The award is presented jointly by the Southern Division of the American Fisheries Society, the Southeastern Section of the Wildlife Society and Southeastern Association of Fish and

> Wildlife Agencies. Among Taylor's many accolades, the most impressive may be what the agency accomplished in the arena of youth outreach. Under his watch, the SCDNR built a youth shooting sports program, including clay target sports and archery, almost from the ground up. The program now reaches more than 44,000 students in schools and clubs across

accomplishments the state. Recently the clay target sports' championship trail of skeet, trap lished a Governor's Cup top prize to recognize the best in high school clay target sports. Besides mentoring in safety and conservation offered to participants, shooters have the opportunity to compete for more than \$125,000 in college scholarship money through this program.

Besides working so hard for youth projects and protecting more than one million acres of public land, Taylor worked equally hard to provide leadership and increased funding for the many SCDNR teams, including biologists and technicians who toil to restore habitats and protect wildlife species native to the Palmetto State. In this role, Taylor notably led the South Carolina Quail Council as chairman of the steering committee in the agency's renewed efforts to restore bobwhite quail in South Carolina in sustainable, huntable numbers. That effort already has produced success and offers much hope for the future of grassland birds in South Carolina.



Tips to encourage your child to adopt healthy eating habits

(StatePoint) While there is a lot of guidance available about what to feed children, until now, there has been little guidance about how to feed them. New recommendations offer parents and caregivers practical tips for encouraging healthy eating habits vital to growth, development and health.

"Childhood is a critical period for developing lifelong eating habits, and home is one of the first places where these habits emerge," says Megan Lott, MPH, RD, deputy director of Healthy Eating Research (HER). "As a registered dietitian and parent myself, I know that reluctance to try new foods and other picky eating habits are common in childhood."

In an effort to make mealtimes easier for families, HER, a national program of the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation (RWJF) based at Duke University, recently convened a panel that reviewed scientific research to develop recommendations for how to feed children ages 2-8.

They found that structuring the home to provide healthy choices and supporting children's independence in trying and learning to like new foods are more effective than pressuring children to eat. They also found that the single most effective strategy to get kids to eat healthy food is through repeated exposure. Here's a snapshot of the panel's top tips:

• Promote independence: Giving kids some control at mealtime helps them learn to like healthful foods. Avoid pressuring kids to finish everything on their plate. Instead, help them learn to identify when they're hungry or full.

• Get them involved: Get kids involved in meal selection and preparation. Even very young children can help wash fruits and vegeta-

• Make mealtime fun: Give foods fun names, share family recipes and food traditions, and talk about your favorite dishes.

• Avoid food rewards: Bribing with sweet treats is tempting, but non-food rewards are more effective in the long run. You can also use praise, like "Good job trying the beans!" to convey love and encourage trying healthy food. · Create a positive envi-

ronment: Provide an environment that lends itself to healthy habits. Keep a bowl of fruit on the counter and chopped vegetables in the fridge. Portion healthy snacks into individual-serving size containers and leave them at kids' eye level and within reach. Offer veg-

etables as an appetizer to give kids the opportunity to eat healthy foods when hungry and without other competing food. Limit the number of unhealthy snacks in

the house.

• Try, try again: Toddlers and preschoolers commonly go through a phase of fearing new foods, however, most kids grow out of this. Try to be patient. It often takes time for kids to develop new, healthy eating habits. Repeated exposure matters. In fact, kids may need to try something 10-15 times before knowing if they like it or not, and this can happen over weeks or months and through different preparations. To avoid food waste, start small. For a new food, consider offering just a few bites.

· Be a role model: Kids often look around them for cues about what to eat, and they look up to you! Let them see you make healthy choices, for your sake and theirs.

"The recommendations were designed to give parents, caregivers and the providers who work with children reliable information about what we know works," says Lott. "However, our national policies must do a better job of supporting the health and well-being of children and families, prioritizing equity, and making healthy food available to and affordable for everyone."


