Several system leaders offered remarks to the volunteers to express their gratitude and the impact the volunteers have made on patient care.

Brian Earnest, Vice President of Revenue Cycle, shared a famous quote from Fred Rogers, a man affectionately known as "Mister Rogers" from his preschool public television series "Mister Rogers' Neighborhood."

The time spent hiking parallels the energy she has put into volunteering with the healthcare system. She currently volunteers at Spartanburg Medical Center - Mary Black Campus by greeting patients as they come in and helping them navigate their way around the hospital.

"My second home is the hospital. I am so comfortable there," she said. "I just enjoy helping people. It's just important for visitors to come in, and they have someone there with a smiling face."

Power Up Spartanburg celebrates one year

Power Up Spartanburg, led by OneSpartanburg, Inc. and funded by Spartanburg County, is a movement to transform Spartanburg County into the top place in the U.S. to start, run and grow a small or minority business.

Since launching on March 21, 2023, Power Up Spartanburg has engaged with more than 1,600 small businesses or entrepreneurs looking to establish a business in Spartanburg County.

Based on self-reporting through a six-month survey, Power Up Spartanburg participants have seen revenue growth of \$5.1 million. That same self-reporting data showed participating businesses were able to increase their payrolls by 167 full-time or contract workers.

Programs Launched Through Power Up Spartanburg

- Power Up Funding made \$10+ million in loans and a pool of grant funding available to small and minority businesses. Community Development Financial Institutions (CDFIs) -

- including the CLIMB Fund, Carolina Foothills Federal Credit Union, and Grow America (formerly the National Development Council) - are fiduciary agents for these funding opportunities.

- Since launching, a total of \$2.4 million, \$1.9 million in loans and \$490K in grants, has been awarded with more in the approval process.

- Power Up Experts has made vetted, committed subject matter experts available in the following areas: finance, legal, HR, and marketing. Power Up Spartanburg will pay for consultations and can provide an allowance for approved projects.

- Power Up Securing Contracts has opened up opportunities for small businesses to make potentially life-changing connections with big businesses and corporations.

- So far, this program has led to participating small businesses earning contracts with organizations like Google, Prisma Health, Oshkosh Defense, and BMW Manufacturing Co.

- Power Up Mentoring, modeled after the renowned

- MIT Venture Mentoring Service, recruits and trains participating mentors to assist small and minority businesses on their journey to success. The program is supported by a \$50,000 investment from The Truist Foundation.

- Since scaling up in March, Power Up Mentoring has grown to 54 mentors working with 28 small and minority business-owners. The pilot phase of Power Up Mentoring led to a new business launching, another opening a second location, a small business securing a contract with Google, and more.

- Power Up University, launched in partnership with Spartanburg County's higher education institutions and supported by a \$50K investment from Bank of America, provides small and minority business-owners the chance to complete a business-centered certification or degree.

- So far, the initiative has partnered with Spartanburg Community College and USC Upstate. Details on the curriculum for Spartanburg Methodist College are still in the works.

German-based carbon fiber bicycle rim manufacturer acquired by American ownership group, expanding manufacturing to Spartanburg County

Munich Composites GmbH, a manufacturer of carbon fiber bicycle rims, has been acquired by a new group in South Carolina headed by local wheel manufacturer Boyd Cycling. This new company, Munich Composites SC, will continue to produce carbon fiber bicycle rims in Europe and expand production into Spartanburg County.

Munich Composites SC will expand European production to serve existing and new customers in the European market. The company's Spartanburg County facility will bring its patented braided carbon fiber rim manufacturing process and products to North America.

The investment totals nearly \$2 million and 32 new jobs. Both facilities will be operational by mid-summer 2024.

Established in 2013, Munich Composites GmbH has pioneered automated carbon fiber layup by utilizing a unique braided construction combined with resin transfer molding (RTM). The manufacturer's construction creates a stronger rim by having continuous fiber throughout the entire surface.

Compared to labor-intensive carbon construction, a braided rim doesn't require as much cutting and placing by-hand.

The South Carolina-based ownership group is led by Boyd and Nicole Johnson of Boyd Cycling as well as Cardinal Cycling Group, and other investors. Munich Composites' state-of-the-art S.C. factory will be located in Landrum in collaboration with Clemson University, Cardinal Cycling Group, and the SC Fraunhofer Alliance.

"Spartanburg County has been able to recruit globally-renowned manufacturers for years now, and it's truly exciting to see our community bring in advanced manufacturing for world-class cycling. I welcome Munich Composites to Spartanburg County and I'm eager to see the type of success they establish in our community," stated Spartanburg County Council Vice Chairman and Economic Development Committee Chairman David Britt

The facility will be located along the Saluda Grade Rail Trail, a 31-mile rail line, formerly owned by Norfolk Southern, that was purchased by a coalition of Conserving Carolina, PAL: Play, Advocate, Live Well, and Upstate Forever.

Greenville celebrates groundbreaking for live music venue Trueline

Greenville's musical community celebrated Thursday, April 25, as ground was broken for Trueline, a live music venue coming to the city's West End.

Jackhammers, celebrity drop-ins and (of course) live music highlighted Thursday's festivities at the future home of Trueline, 401 Rhett St. The music venue is the brainchild of Michael Grozier, who also co-founded the legendary House of Blues concert venues and is currently an executive at the entertainment giant Live Nation.

Grozier said Greenville's welcoming nature convinced him of the venue's potential. "I came to

Greenville and as everybody knows, you fall in love with Greenville right away," he said. "The most

amazing thing is the kindness in this town, the patience, the love for people."

Anticipated to open in April 2025, Trueline will feature two performance

spaces, a 1,700-seat main room and a 400-seat "more intimate" space. That smaller room, Grozier said, will be named "The

Handlebar," a tribute to the long-time music venue that shaped the city's live music scene until it closed its doors in 2014.

Groundbreaking attendees included nationally-known recording artists, such as Greenville natives and blues artists Marcus King and Mac Arnold, as well as South Carolina's country music standout Josh Turner.

Greenville Mayor Knox White said the project is a testament to the city's commitment to economic and community growth. "We're not a bunch of naysayers who look for reasons not to do something," he said, "We look for reasons to do it."

Duke Energy completes multiyear unit upgrades in Upstate to support the Carolinas' growing electricity demand

Charlotte, NC - As strong economic development successes and population growth power the Carolinas' energy needs, Duke Energy's goal is to ensure energy reliability for its customers.

Duke Energy recently completed upgrades to the four units at the Bad Creek pumped storage facility in Salem, S.C. The upgrades add a total of 320 megawatts of carbon-free energy to the company's system and brings the total capacity of the station to 1,680 megawatts.

A flexible, dynamic, efficient and green way to store and deliver large quantities of energy, pumped storage hydro plants store and generate energy by moving water between two reservoirs at different elevations.

Coming online in 1991, Bad Creek is designed to produce significant amounts of energy when our customers need it most, performing a vital role as the largest "battery" on the company's system.

"This investment in Bad Creek demonstrates our commitment to improving reliability across the Carolinas. Pumped storage technology gives us operational flexibility, allowing us to store energy and then deploy that energy when



customer demand is highest," said Preston Gillespie, executive vice president and chief generation officer and enterprise operational excellence. "Expanding our energy storage capabilities is just one of the many steps we are taking in the next phase of our energy transition."

The units were upgraded

in phases, adding 80 MW of capacity to each new pump turbine. Unit 2 was completed in 2020, unit 1 was completed in 2021, unit three was completed in 2023 and unit 4 was completed in April.

Duke Energy is currently working to extend the license of the Bad Creek pumped hydro storage

facility, which is set to expire in 2027. In addition to this upgrade project, Duke Energy is evaluating the potential to add a second powerhouse at Bad Creek that would further help Duke Energy add capacity to the system as well as address increasing

system variability, from the growth of solar and customer usage, in a reliable and affordable way. If pursued, the second powerhouse could be in-service as early as 2034.

"From population growth to the expansion of manufacturing and other

major economic development wins, the Carolinas are booming," said Mike Callahan, Duke Energy's South Carolina president. "We must have a diverse energy mix to account for this growth on the coldest winter nights and the warmest summer days. We continue to look at solutions like expanding Bad Creek to make sure the power is there when customers need it, and it is as affordable as possible – providing certainty as they go about their daily lives."

Expanding operations at Bad Creek also provides significant economic benefits of \$7.3 billion to South Carolina, as the state benefits from construction and general infrastructure activity, by 2033.
