A happy (and healthy) Thanksgiving!

Most people eat more at Thanksgiving dinner than they consume in a normal day, and then continue overeating at year-end. So it helps to have a plan in place to avoid any holiday gobbling that you might pay for later.

Turkey, yams, mashed potatoes, green beans and cranberry sauce are all nutritious, so long as lots of salt, sugar and butter haven't been added to them, says Kathleen Duran-Thal, director of nutrition at Cooper Healthy Living at the Cooper Clinic in Dallas.

An earlier study by researchers at the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development and the National Institute of Diabetes and Digestive and Kidney Diseases found that Americans usually gain only one pound during the winter holidays, but the weight put on then isn't shed in the new year.

Keeping weight stable in the fall and winter may help prevent age-related weight gain and associated diseases, says Dr. Riva Rahl, medical director at Cooper Wellness. In addition to not looking or feeling top-notch, adults with excess weight are at greater risk of heart disease, high blood pressure, diabetes and certain cancers, she says.

Cooper Wellness experts say to go ahead and enjoy your favorite Thanksgiving foods, but consider making healthy choices at your turkey dinner. They offer some tips for keeping you from fiddling with your belt at the end of the meal.

1. First of all, don't arrive at a Thanksgiving dinner hungry. Eat a good breakfast, and maybe even lunch that day.

2. Fill half your plate with vegetables, one quarter of it with lean meat, and one quarter with starches like mashed potatoes and turkey dressing.

3. Choose white-meat turkey and avoid eating the skin.

4. Avoid gravy. Turkey doesn't need to be smothered in gravy to taste good. If you want gravy, just drip a little on your meat and potatoes.

5. Limit yourself to small helpings of heavily sweetened yams and cranberry sauces.

6. Use restraint when dinner rolls are passed around. Buttered rolls may melt in your mouth, but they're full of calories, so eat only one.

7. Try sampling in moderation the many foods that you have looked forward to. And consider bringing something healthy to the dinner, like a side dish that's low in fat, sugar and salt.

8. Eat slowly. By eating Thanksgiving dinner slowly, your body has time to register when it is full so that you don't consume too much.

9. At dessert time, try to choose the lightest options.

10. After Thanksgiving dinner, take a walk with your friends or family. Fifteen minutes of walking will get your blood circulating and can burn off 100 calories, says Susie Kania, exercise physiologist and director at Cooper Wellness.

That belief drives the new Shi Institute for Sustainable Communities at Furman University, a regionally centered, community-focused institute that promotes sustainable human flourishing through its centers for sustainability education, research and leadership. The shift to a more broadly reaching institute culminates 11 years of progress and national renown as Furman's David E. Shi Center for Sustainability. Recently on Oct. 27, Furman announced the new institute – an education, applied research and leadership resource truly unique to the Southeast.

"It is our imperative to preserve the Earth's limited natural resources for current populations, to achieve a just and equitable society for all, and to leave future generations with a planet capable of sustaining life and community," said Furman President Elizabeth Davis. "The Shi Institute brings a holistic, interdisciplinary approach to our most pressing sustainability and community challenges, while providing our students with formative learning experiences through our programs and partnerships within the region."

ronmental scientists and economists, urban planners and policy experts, sustainability leaders and elected officials will collaboratively pursue sustainable communities at the Shi Institute, which operates in a net zero, sustainable showcase home in the heart of Furman's campus.

"The Shi Institute fills a critical regional need and will serve as a conduit and crossroads for providing innovative ways to think and learn about sustainability, applying sustainability systems research to contemporary problems, and convening, connecting and educating the next generation of campus and community sustainability leaders," said Wes Dripps, the institute's executive director and a professor of earth, environmental and sustainability sciences.

"The future of sustainable societies requires that we find ways to move forward in a collaborative, holistic way that views societal sustainability through the interaction of various systems environmental, social and economic. This approach requires institutions with interdisciplinary expertise, conceptual imagination and local partnerships like we have."

David E. Shi, former Furman president and the namesake of the institute, also pointed to the rich educational opportunities the institute will offer students and the far-reaching way the university is approaching sustainability.

"Furman is among a handful of universities that believes engaged learning, experiential learning, offcampus learning, real world learning, should be the centerpiece of its educational experience," he said. The Shi Institute will house three centers: The Center for Sustainability

Education, The Center for Applied Sustainability Research, and The Center for Sustainability Leadership.

Innovation in education: Today's students are tomorrow's leaders, change agents and decision makers. The Center for Sustainability Education will offer novel sustainability education programs designed to provide new ways of thinking, collaborating, and problemsolving and the skills and knowledge necessary to deal with the sustainability challenges of the 21st century. The center already provides a vast array of high impact student learning experiences including working on the Furman Farm, living in the Sustainable Greenbelt Living Community, and participating in our flagship Student Fellows Program, which engages students in real world, campus and community sustainability fellowships, with offerings during the summer and the academic year. To date the Institute has hosted over 325 student fellows.




How COVID-19 has changed the way we do business forever

(StatePoint) The COVID-19 pandemic has fundamentally changed how business gets done. And when it comes to midsized and small businesses, the importance of investing in new technology, facilitating remote work and maintaining a tech-savvy workforce has never been so clear, according to a new survey.

This is a trend that's likehere to stay. ly Approximately a quarter of small businesses operating remotely expect -- and want -- these changes to remain permanent after COVID-19 subsides, and about 40% of middle market executives expect the same, with some seeing it as a means to grow the company.

However, this digital transformation puts a premium on a tech-savvy workforce able to support customers and collaborate with colleagues remotely. While many believe their current workforce has the skills to keep up, businesses are also substantially more likely than last year to say companies need to focus on hiring tech-savvy talent.

Letters Reach Out to Troubled Vets

We've been in a stressful period for nany long months, and now here come the holidays. It's going to be different this year: fewer (or no) family get-togethers, no parties, little shopping at stores ... in other words, a potentially lonely time for many veterans who are sad or anxious or who have PTSD. The Department of Veterans Affairs

has done a randomized evaluation of its Caring Letters Program to test the effects of sending a written letter every month to veterans who have called the Veteran Crisis Line. One result was that when asked, 85% of psychiatric patient veterans agreed or strongly agreed that they would like to receive caring communication through the mail, and the period of time was monthly for one year. (This rated higher than receiving email or text messages.) Granted, given the setting, most of them said that contact with a mental health counselor or physician was preferred, but I expect that a message from a friend or acquaintance or another veteran would likely be just as welcome.

At this point, the Veteran Crisis Line has sent letters to 90,000 veterans over the past year.

What can you do? You can reach out to a veteran you suspect might be struggling, whether it's with suicidal thoughts or just loneliness. Monthly cards or letters in the mail to say hello are small things that can be huge to receive when someone is alone and struggling. Keep the communication brief, but caring.

If you honestly don't know any veterans who might be struggling right now, make a call to the chaplain of your local American Legion or Veterans of Foreign Wars and ask if there's nyone they're worried about. If you're going to do this, make a nitment to yourself right now that you'll do this monthly for a minimum of one year.
