USC Upstate lands \$750,000 NSF grant for STEM scholarships

The University of South Carolina Upstate has been awarded a six-year, \$750,000 National Science Foundation (NSF) Scholarships in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (S-STEM) Program grant. USC Upstate will use the funding to establish the Career Readiness to Inspire STEM Proficiency and Retention (CRISPR) program, which will help boost the recruitment, retention, and graduation of STEM students.

The CRISPR program will provide scholarship support for two cohorts of seven scholars (biology and chemistry majors) who will each receive up to \$8,100 each year for up to four years. The first cohort will kick off in Fall 2023, and the second in Fall 2024.

"Having a robust science workforce is key to the health and wellbeing of the community, as evidenced by the COVID-19 pandemic," said USC Upstate Chancellor Bennie L. Harris, Ph.D. "This grant will help remove financial barriers for students who can excel in the pursuit of biology or chemistry degrees to contribute to that workforce."

The primary objectives of the CRISPR program are to help USC Upstate:

- * Recruit academically talented, low-income students interested in studying biology and chemistry.

- * Increase the retention and graduation rates of biology and chemistry students.

- * Ensure that scholars have the necessary career skills to be employed as valuable contributors to the STEM workforce through professional development activities that enhance knowledge of STEM career opportunities and career readiness, equipping them for employment or graduate studies.

CRISPR scholars will have access to a variety of resources aimed at helping

them chart their career courses. These opportunities will include pre-college orientation, mentoring, research and internship experiences, and career-readiness initiatives.

"One goal of the grant is workforce development, and we hope scholarship recipients learn what rich career opportunities exist for those with degrees in biology and chemistry right here in South Carolina," said Jeannie Chapman, Ph.D., dean of USC Upstate College of Science and Technology. "Furthermore, we will equip them with the skillset they need to be competitive for the many job vacancies in these fields."

Program leaders believe all biology and chemistry students at USC Upstate will benefit from the CRISPR program as successful elements of the program will be incorporated into the regular curriculum long after the funding period has ended. These resources could also be applied to the university's other academic programs to enhance learning experiences and student performance.

An online portal will be set up later this semester so students can apply. Paper applications will be available through high school guidance counselors and science teachers.

Eligibility will be limited to full-time students who meet the NSF S-STEM program's citizenship/residen-

cy requirements, are accepted to USC Upstate, declare a biology or chemistry major, and are Pell-eligible with unmet financial need. Additionally, potential scholars must have at least a 3.0 high school GPA.

"Our hope is that scholarship funding from this grant allows recipients to focus on their coursework and to participate in the many high-impact practices offered at USC Upstate," said Astrid Rosario, Ph.D., an associate professor of chemistry at USC Upstate who was the principal investigator for the grant proposal.

Co-principal investigators for the proposal included USC Upstate faculty members Ben Montgomery, Ph.D., Colby King, Ph.D., and Susannah Waldrop. Justin Travis, Ph.D., will serve as the social sciences researcher.

This most recent NSF grant is in addition to the one USC Upstate was awarded two years ago to address the region's need for highly qualified STEM teachers. The university, in partnership with Spartanburg Community College and Spartanburg County schools, received the five-year, \$1.2 million NSF Robert Noyce Teacher Scholarship Program grant to fund scholarships for USC Upstate students pursuing dual undergraduate degrees in mathematics, biology, or chemistry, and secondary education.

New NCAA Division I Collegiate Golf Tournament shines spotlight on Spartanburg

Welcoming 15 universities stretching up and down the entirety of the East Coast and to the Midwest – the Carolina Cup will tee off Sunday, October 9, to Tuesday, October 11, at the Carolina Country Club in Spartanburg.

The first annual tournament is attracting teams including the University of Connecticut, Howard University and the University of Central Florida to the region. Tournament hosts USC Upstate and Wofford College are among the teams representing South Carolina.

"Hosting the Carolina Cup is a big deal for Spartanburg County. It's not every day you welcome athletes from 15 of the top athletics pro-

grams in the country to your city," said Billy Dunlap, Chief Tourist Development Officer, OneSpartanburg, Inc. "We're excited to roll out the red carpet for the coaches, athletes and their families, and to show them all Spartanburg has to offer during their stay."

Net proceeds from the tournament are set for donation to Spartanburg-area philanthropic organizations, including Children's Cancer Partners of the Carolinas and First Tee – Upstate South Carolina as nominated charities supported by the Carolina Cup.

The Carolina Cup also features play on Saturday, October 8, with 30 collegiate players joining representatives from corporate

GSSM senior contributes to NASCAR research at Ford Performance Technical Center

Hartsville – Marilyn Bertok has always been on the fast track. As a senior at the SC Governor's School for Science & Mathematics (GSSM), her summer research project was conducting NASCAR research at the Ford Performance Technical Center in Concord, N.C.

Bertok was born with racing in her blood. Her parents and grandparents have competed in various disciplines of motorsports. Her family now owns and operates Panic Motorsports in West Columbia, South Carolina, so naturally, 17-year-old Bertok's summer research was destined to revolve around auto racing.

"My grandfather did rally," Bertok said. "My grandmother did navigating for him for a little while, and then my mom started in autocross and went to spec Miata's, and my dad was doing drag racing when he met my mom and then switched over (to road course racing)."

At GSSM, all students are required to participate in a research experience before graduation. Many students do this research in the summer between their junior and senior years. Prior to entering her senior year at GSSM, Bertok was contacted by Ford

Performance Simulation Engineer, Dan Tiley, and this past summer, Bertok became the Ford Performance Technical Center's first-ever high school intern.

"I've personally known Marilyn and her family since she was about four-years-old," Tiley said. "Her dad and I have raced sportscars together in SCCA, both as a team and as competitors for over 13 years. It's been a joy watching Marilyn grow up at the race track, and as an engineer in auto racing myself, it's very exciting to see her take control of her educational and eventual career plans at such a young age. She's a girl with big plans, and huge aspirations. It was a honor and a pleasure hosting her here at Ford Performance this summer."

Despite being the only female on the team, Bertok made her mark while cre-

ating customized race-tracks for their Driver in the Loop (DiL) Simulator and collecting data that's absolutely essential to Ford Performance's efforts in NASCAR.

"Getting to work at Ford Performance was an incredible opportunity," Bertok said. "I was able to walk into a completely new situation and learn how to do processes I've never seen before with minimal issues because of going to school at GSSM. I was able to take the skills I learned to deal with problems in Engineering and

other classes and apply them to my internship, which made the whole thing much easier."

During her research, Bertok learned how to use the programs at the Ford Performance Technical Center and how to run the life-size simulator. Working long days, five days a week, she assisted

the team wherever she could contribute. Bertok's success stemmed from the time she spent in GSSM's Accelerate program during her sophomore year. Accelerate is an intensive engineering program delivered by GSSM and its college partners, that offers virtual synchronous and blended courses to 10th, 11th, and 12th-grade students at high schools throughout the state of South Carolina. She said that the Accelerate program aided her in understanding the technology that the Ford Performance Center was utilizing on the biggest stage in American auto racing.

"Really, GSSM helped

me with the technology side of things and knowing what I'm talking about," Bertok said. "In my sophomore year, I was part of the Accelerate program and took an Engineering course, and that significantly helped with just reading through hundreds of lines of code and figuring out what needs to be changed to get it to do what I want it to."

Bertok expects to graduate from GSSM in May of 2023. Following graduation, she hopes to attend a four-year university, where she can major in Motorsports Engineering and Mechanical Engineering.


